WHAT TO BRING

- A healthy morning tea and lunch
- A labelled drink bottle for water
- Wear sun-safe clothing with sleeves & collar
- Wear enclosed sports shoes and socks
- Sun-safe hat - legionnaire or bucket hat with wide brim
- If applicable - Medical Management Plan and medication (details below)

- SPF50+ sunscreen
- Water to refill bottles

DON'T FORGET

- Do not include food items that need to be reheated
- Children will not be able to purchase food while off site
- Label all items with child's name
- **We are an allergy aware service - do not bring nuts, eggs or kiwi fruit**

CHANGES

Changes to activities:

In the unlikely event that an activity is unable to run, an alternative activity will be provided.

Activities and times are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather or provider availability.

Bus departure and arrival times are indicative only. Contact your service for accurate times.

Changes to your booking:

If you need to make a change to your booking contact your service via phone or email before 6pm **Friday 21 March 2025**. No cancellations are accepted after 6pm, **Friday 21 March 2025** with bookings non-refundable. There are no refunds for days your child does not attend a booked day.

MEDICAL MANAGEMENT PLAN & MEDICATION

All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including but not limited to allergies, food/chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy, diabetes and FPIES, will need to provide:

- a completed Medical Management Plan with a colour photo and coloured plan*
- necessary medication and accompanying documentation*

*as detailed in the Medical Conditions Factsheet for Parents and Guardians.

Please note: it is a legal requirement under the Education and Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking that these are provided. A parent will need to sign the required authorisations including a Risk Minimisation Plan.

In the interests of child safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication not be supplied as per the Ambrose Medical Conditions Policy. Fees will still be payable.

FEES & CHILD CARE SUBSIDY

Invoices are issued fortnightly. Payment of fees is via direct debit, which occurs fortnightly on Thursdays. New families joining the service will need to setup direct debit via Xplor for the service.

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) is a payment offered by the Australian Government for which parents/guardians may be eligible, to assist with the cost of fees. Ambrose School Age Care services are approved for CCS. Subsidy amounts are calculated and approved by the Australian Government Department of Human Services (Services Australia). The parents/guardians CCS eligibility requirements must be met with Services Australia and all relevant and correct CCS details provided to the service together with signing the Complying Written Arrangement and confirming the CCS enrolment in MyGov before eligible CCS can be paid.
